





History of Sibi

Sibi is a city in the Balochistan province of Pakistan. The climatic and topography of Sibi District is quite varied compared to other districts of Balochistan. It is also known as the "Hot spot" of Pakistan where the temperatures in the summer exceed far above normal 52.6 °C (126.7 °F).

Sibi Mela

The Sibi Mela is an annual cultural show held in Sibi, in the Balochistan Province of Pakistan. The first Sibi Mela was held in Sibi in January 1885.^[1] It has subsequently developed into a cultural festival, with animal markets, camel racing, tent pegging and exhibitions of handicraft tribal dresses and folk dances.

The Government of Bombay Revenue Department in their Resolution No. 4794, dated 6 July 1886, declared the results of this second horse show to be very satisfactory and observed that the horse show promised to become in future a good market for remounts.^[2]

As a result of the continued success of the fair the Government of India was asked to sanction an annual monetary grant towards the fair's expenses in future and though no grant could be made for the year under review a provisional sanction to the allotment of Rs 1,000 was given for the fair of 1887.

The 1887 fair began on 19 January and continued until 25 January. Brigadier General Luck C. B. commanding in Sindh was President of the Judging Committee and Mr. Helen General Superintendent Horse Breeding Operations in India was one of members. The total number of horses brought to the show was estimated to be 1,400, of which no less than 1,022 competed for prizes as against 594 in previous year. The Sibi Mela annually held in the city after the creation of Pakistan. Muhammad Ali Jinnah visited Sibi attended the annual gathering of Sibi Mela 1948 and addressed the tribal Leaders and people.

The Mela 2025 ended on 17th February 2025


































Sibi District, which has a current population of 224,148, of which 103,332 are between the ages of 15 and 49, which we call the eligible couples.

To educate all these populations about reproductive health and the benefits of balanced family, our program includes 9 Family Welfare centers, two mobile service units, one reproductive health Service center, 6 social Mobilizers, and recently the department has deployed 15 community-based family planning workers in the program.

From January 2024 to February 2025, The Service providers have conduced and arranged approximately 1196 activities to aware the public through contraceptive Extension camps, satellite clinics, and Awareness session etc.

At present, our Family welfare centers are functioning in different areas of the district, including Luni, Dehpal, Marghazani, Tali, Lehri, Allahabad, Sibi City, and where there are no Family Welfare centers, we provide services by camping through mobile services, and 15 community-based family planning workers and social mobilizers are also creating awareness among the public through lectures and other means.

Wherever there is a national, regional activity or any other program, the staff of the Population Welfare Department considers it an opportunity and try to convey their message.

In which a special national program is the Sibi Mela, which is held every year, in which people from all corners of the country come. In which all kinds of cultural programs, horse racing, and buying and selling of livestock are held. In which the dignitary such as Ministers come for the inauguration and conclusion.

The Sibi Mela 2025 was inaugurated by Sardar Kohiyar Domki Minister for Industry and the closing program was conducted by Asim Kurd Geeloo Minister for Renue Government of Balochistan. The festival was also attended by Mr. Meer Faisal Khan Jamali Advisor for Live Stock and Mr. Mian Khan Bugti, Member National Assembly.

At the same time, the heads of most departments of the Balochistan government and other prominent Institution exhibit their products and all this causes a rush. Therefore, the Population Welfare Department takes advantage of this opportunity and sets up its stall regularly. This year The Worthy Secretary Mr. Abdullah and Mr. Muhammad Azeem Khan Kakar Stricrly instruct to establish stall properly to, maintain its traditions, it set up a stall. The stall had various slogans and expert staff that not only informed the people but also provided various types of advice and help. Mr. Malik Naeem Khan provides IEC Material. The stall was very much liked by government employees, local elders and tribal figures. The current fair continued from February 13 to February 17. There was a rush of men and women on a daily basis and February 15 was reserved only for women. Along with the fair, women took a lot of interest in our stall and it was a insist from visitors that in the future this stall and other resources will continue to serve the people.
